

Housing Choice Voucher Payment Standards

Effective November 1, 2021

This is the maximum amount of monthly assistance a property owner can receive from HASLO for gross rent (rent plus utilities). A family receiving a housing voucher can select a unit with a rent that is above the payment standard, but will be required to pay the excess amount, in addition to their normal responsibility (30% of their income).

The Types of Vouchers Available

- Housing Choice low income, lottery to be put on waiting list opens periodically. Another lottery upcoming in March 2022.
- Mainstream Reserved for disabled individuals under age 62 provided by qualification, limited number available. Currently closed.
- Set-Aside Limited number of housing choice vouchers made available at 5CHC agency discretion.
- *Emergency Housing Voucher* available to those who are homeless or at risk of homelessness limited number available provided by qualification. New allotment expected in 2023.
- HUD-VASH Veteran, income qualified, case-managed clients by VA. Closed due to limited VA staff to perform Case Management, although vouchers are available.
- Project-Based Vouchers Tied to the housing unit, not the individual. Housing unit is permanently set-aside for people who qualify for the project - For example, Willow Walk Apartments dedicated to low-income seniors.
- Foster Youth to Independence Vouchers Ages 18-24, assistance up to 36 months. Coupled with supportive services to assist the young person on their path to self-sufficiency.

Note: The voucher does not come with available housing except for Project-Based Vouchers. Thus, if someone receives a voucher, they are given a limited number of months to lease-up or lose the voucher. They are often times unable to find the housing and be able to move in before lease-up timeline expires.
