



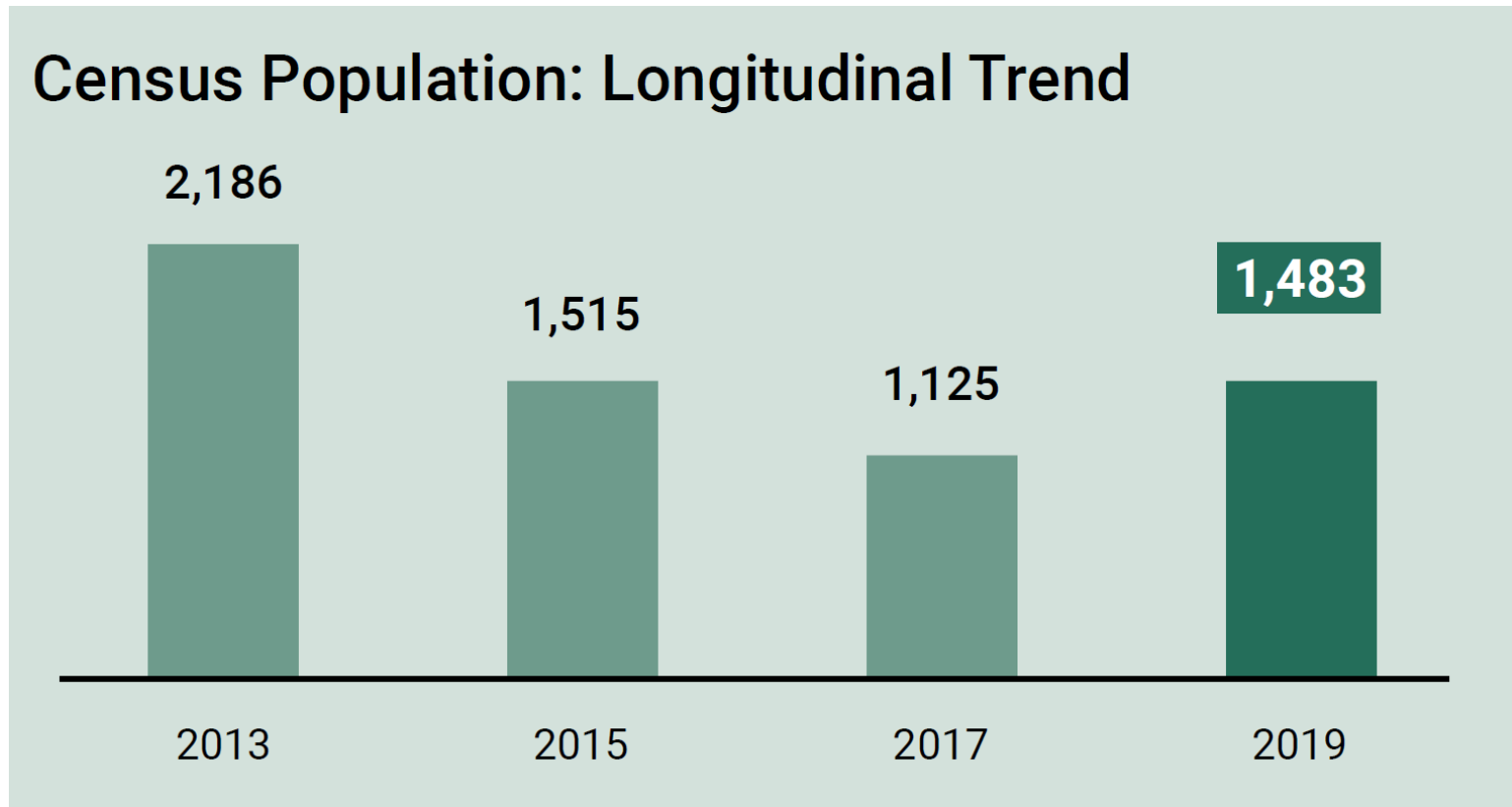

Ordinance Establishing Local Standards and Procedures for the Design, Site Development, and Operation of Emergency Homeless Shelters at Public Facilities



Homelessness as a Priority



Proposed Ordinance

- Guided by Government Code 8698
- Reaffirms shelter crisis in San Luis Obispo County
- Adopts local minimum building and life safety standards
- Applies only to emergency shelters installed on property owned or leased by the County
- Ordinance expires 12/31/2022, unless County Board extends



Proof of Concept in South County

- 5CHC to lead temporary emergency shelter, in partnership with County and City Grover Beach
 - *3/16/2021 Board approved \$1,189,457 ESG funds for 5CHC*
- Located on County-owned property at 286 16th St, Grover Beach
 - *Co-located with County Health Clinic, Drug and Alcohol Services, Courthouse*
- What's proposed in proof of concept?
 - 20 cabins by referral only with specific limitations on clients admitted
 - Wrap around supportive services for clients
 - On-site 5CHC staffing 24/7 with additional security measures
